PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION/PROPERTIES:

Viscous, white/pink pigmented aqueous solution. Specific Gravity: approx 1.7; pH: 11

HEALTH EFFECTS

SWALLOWED: Industrial chemicals should never be taken internally, slightly toxic.
